ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A66 TRUNK ROAD (WAITLANDS LANE, RAVENSWORTH) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS)

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A66 Trunk Road in the District of Richmond, which will come into force on Monday 20 December 2004. The effect of the Order is to make permanent the prohibition which came into force under an Experimental Order on 23 February 2004, as described in issue number 57212 of *The London Gazette* dated 20 February 2004 (Ref 504).

A copy of the Order and the relevant plan have been deposited at Richmond Library, Queens Road, Richmond, North Yorkshire DL10 4AE, where they may be inspected during normal opening.
