THE BARNET (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (1997, NO 53) (AMENDMENT NO) TRAFFIC ORDER 200

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

This Order would amend existing waiting restrictions in Hampden Way and Chase Way, London N14, in order to improve safety at the junction and provide additional parking.

(1) The At Any Time waiting restriction on Hampden Way between Chase Way and outside No 71 Hampden Way would be extended by 14 metres to outside No 67 Hampden Way to improve sight lines for vehicles exiting Chase Way onto Hampden Way.

(2) A 20 metre section of existing waiting restriction by the side of the surgery in Chase Way would be removed to provide additional parking.

THE BARNET (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (2000, NO 17) (AMENDMENT NO 23) TRAFFIC ORDER 2005

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on 20 April 2005, an Order under section 6 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

This general effect of the Order will be to provide parking bays for vehicles displaying a valid disabled Blue Badge at the locations detailed in Schedule 1 to this notice and to revoke the parking bays specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 200

THE BRENT (PARKING PLACES) (NO 4, 2001) (AMENDMENT NO $\,$) ORDER 200

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading Restrictions" Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice; (b) waiting by vehicles (including waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in a certain length of Chamberlayne Road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(c) the prohibition on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be revoked in the length of Chamberlayne Road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice:

(d) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be prohibited between 11.00 am and 6.30 pm throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice:

(e) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited (except on Sundays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1) unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(f) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising would be prohibited; and

(g) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the
