

(Note: in some circumstances this will involve the conversion of existing parking space currently used by other vehicles and the loss of that type of existing parking space).

(b) to change the operational times of the residents' parking places on the east side of Ingleborough Street so that it will operate at any time;

(c) to remove some existing parking space as specified in Schedule 10 to this notice and replace it with a ban on waiting by vehicles which will apply either at any time or from 8.30 am to 5.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays;

(d) to ban waiting by vehicles in parts of the streets specified in Schedules 11 and 12 to this notice during the times specified at the beginning of those Schedules (instead of any existing ban on waiting by vehicles);

(e) to re-define certain existing parking places (including police and doctor parking places and motor cycle parking areas) so that they accord with the definitions of the new and extended parking places and more accurately reflect the situation on the ground. There will be no change to the way these parking places currently operate.

3. The charge for the use of a parking place by the pay and display method or by the method of inserting coins into a parking meter will be at the rate of £2 per hour, or pro rata for periods of more or less than 1 hour, up to a maximum of 2 hours or 4 hours, with no return to the parking place within 1 hour of leaving it.

4. The charges for permits will be as follows: for residents' permits for vehicles other than motorcycles £9.60, £18.75, £32.50 and £60 for 1, 3, 6 and 12 months respectively and for motorcycles £11, £17 and £29 for 3, 6 and 12 months respectively; for business permits £495 for 12 months; for teachers' permits £255 for 12 months; for visitors' permits £3.50 per day and for trade permits £2.50 per day.

5. There will be no charge for the use of the parking places/areas/bays specified in Schedules 6, 7, 8 or 9 of this notice.

6. The parking places/areas/bays specified in Schedules 1 to 6 or Schedule 9 will operate between 8.30 am and 5.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays (except Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays). The parking places/areas specified in Schedule 7 or 8 will operate at any time.

Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection from 9.30 am until 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (except Bank Holidays) from 17 June 2005 until the Orders cease to have effect, at the offices of the Lambeth Borough Council's Transport and Highways Group, 3rd Floor, Blue Star House, 234-244 Stockwell Road, Brixton, London SW9 9SP.

9. The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Orders should be continued in force indefinitely by means of permanent Orders made under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person may object to the making of the permanent Orders for the purpose of such indefinite continuation within a period of 6 months beginning with the day on which the experimental Order comes into force or, if the Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force. Any such objection must be in writing and must state the grounds on which it is made and be sent to Transport and Highways Group, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Blue Star House, 234-244 Stockwell Road, Brixton London SW9 9SP. Any objection may be communicated to, or seen by, other persons who may be affected.

10. If any person wishes to question the validity of any of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE 3

Streets on which new parking places will be provided for vehicles displaying either an "SR" residents' permit or an "SB" business or teachers' permit or a visitors' permit or a trade permit and certain existing parking places for those vehicles will be extended in length:

Albion Avenue, Clyston Street, Davidson Gardens, Jeffreys Road, Pascal Street, Pensbury Place, Pensbury Street, Priory Grove, Stewart's Road, Studley Road and Stockwell Park Road.

SCHEDULE 4

Streets on which new parking places will be provided for vehicles displaying either a pay and display ticket purchased from a ticket parking meter (and the vehicle is left for not more than 2 hours) or an "SR" residents' permit or an "SB" business or teacher's permit or a visitor's permit or a trade permit and certain existing parking places for those vehicles will be extended in length:

Clyston Street, Pensbury Place, Pensbury Street and Stewart's Road.

SCHEDULE 5

Streets on which new parking areas will be provided for vehicles displaying either a pay and display ticket purchased from a ticket parking meter (and the vehicle is left for not more than 4 hours) or an "SR" residents' permit or an "SB" business or teachers' permit or a visitors' permit or a trade permit and certain existing parking places for those vehicles will be extended in length:

Albion Avenue, Albert Square, Arlesford Road, Burnley Road, Davidson Gardens, Deeley Road, Gauden Road, Hartington Road, Irving Grove, Larkhall Lane, Lansdowne Way, Mayflower Road, Rhodesia Road, St Michael's Road, Sibella Road, Thessaly Road and Thorncroft Street.

SCHEDULE 6

Streets on which new parking areas will be provided for the use of motorcycles:

Deeley Road, Pensbury Place, Pensbury Street, Stewart's Road and Thessaly Road.

SCHEDULE 7

Streets on which parking places for vehicles displaying a disabled persons' badge will be provided:

Atherford Road, Bromfelde Road, Chelsham Road, Gaskell Street, Gauden Close, Gauden Road, Guildford Road, Hartington Road, Kay Road, Landor Road, Sibella Road, Stockwell Terrace, Stockwell Park Road and Wilkinson Street.

SCHEDULE 8

Streets on which parking areas will be provided for the use of ambulances:

Binfield Road and Stockwell Park Crescent.

SCHEDULE 9

Streets on which loading bays will be provided for the use only of goods vehicles that are being loaded or unloaded for periods of not more than 30 minutes at a time, with no return to the loading bay within 2 hours of leaving it:

Lansdown Way and Larkhall Lane.

SCHEDULE 10

Streets where some parking space for vehicles displaying either an "SR" residents' permit or a visitors' permit or a trade permit will be removed and replaced with waiting restrictions.

Ingleborough Street, Groveway, Hartington Road, Priory Grove and Thorncroft Street.

SCHEDULE 11

New waiting restrictions to apply at any time (double yellow lines) in certain parts of these streets:
