THE A6514 TRUNK ROAD (A52 TO A60) (DETRUNKING) ORDER 200

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Order. An Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that the length of the A6514 Trunk Road, between its junction with the A52 Trunk Road, Nottingham and the A60 Mansfield Road, Woodthorpe, Nottingham, shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road, as from the date on which the Order comes into force.

Copies of the draft Order and the plan referred to in it may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Highways Agency, Traffic Operations Directorate, C3 Broadway, Broad Street, Birmingham B15 1BL; and at the offices of the Chief Executive, Nottingham City Council, The County House, Old Market Square, Nottingham NG1 4BT.

Any person may object to the making of this Order not later than 4 October 2005, or within 6 weeks from the date of first publication of this notice if that period expires later, by notice to the Secretary of State at the offices of the Highways Agency, Traffic Operations Directorate, C3 Broadway, Broad Street, Birmingham B15 1BL, quoting Ref HA 008/001/000092 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

INTEGRATED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL

Notice is hereby given that Speedibake, has applied to the Environment Agency for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (IPPC) permit to operate an installation involving, PPC Regulations Part A(1) section 6.8 (d), (i), of Schedule 1. "The treating and processing materials intended for the production of food products from animal raw materials at a plant with a finished production capacity of more than 75 tonnes per day". The installation is located at Cross Lane, BD4 0SG, in the borough/district of Bradford, in the county of West Yorkshire.

The application contains a description of any foreseeable significant effects of emissions from the installation on the environment.
