London Borough of Camden

THE CAMDEN (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO 147) ORDER 2005

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be:

- (i) to convert a 10 metre length of existing single yellow line waiting restrictions to double at the eastern corner of Adelaide Road and Lower Merton Rise;
- (ii) to convert the existing lengths of single yellow line waiting restrictions to double at the junction of King Henry's Road and Lower Merton Rise;
- (iii) to introduce double yellow line waiting restrictions in Beaumont Place (all that part which is public highway), from Tottenham Court Road, eastwards for a distance of 90 metres;
- (iv) to introduce a 16.8 metres length of double yellow line waiting restrictions in Murray Mews outside the Irish Centre;
- (v) to introduce a 5.1 metres length of double yellow line waiting restrictions in Rochester Road at the western end of Rochester Terrace Gardens;
- (vi) to introduce two new lengths of motorcycle bay in Castlehaven Road and Cannon Hill.
