ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTIONS 14(1)(A) AND 15(2)

ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

LEEDS CITY COUNCIL (SOUTH VIEW ROAD, YEADON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND NO WAITING/LOADING OR UNLOADING AT ANY TIME) ORDER 2005

Notice is hereby given that because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the under-mentioned highway (construction of a new health centre), Leeds City Council intends in not less than 21 days from the date of this notice, to make an Order the effect of which will be:

1. No person shall proceed along or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along South View Road from a point 35 metres north of its junction with Harper Lane to its junction with Town Hall Square. However access will be available to the section of South View Road from Town Hall Square to the rear of the Town Hall at certain times during the period of the works;

2. To introduce a no waiting/loading or unloading restriction on:

(a) South View Road (both sides) between its junction with Harper Lane and its junction with Town Hall Square;

(b) on both sides of the un-named road that runs between the health centre and the Morrisons Car Park from South View Road to Town Hall Square;

for the entire duration of the works.

3. To temporarily suspend the one-way traffic restriction on South View Road from Town Hall Square to the rear of the Town Hall, to enable two-way traffic at the times that this section of highway is not closed.

A diversionary route for vehicles and pedestrians affected by the closure in paragraph 1 above will be available via the un-named road referred to in 2(b) above.

The Order will come into operation on Monday 7 November 2005, and will remain in force for as long as is necessary to enable the relevant works to be completed.

THE CAMDEN (PARKING PLACES) (CA-P) (AMENDMENT NO) ORDER 2005

FORTUNE GREEN CPZ REVIEW

Notice is hereby given, that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Orders will be;

To introduce a new resident parking places on the south side of Achilles Road and extend the existing resident parking place outside No 2 by 2 metres in length;

To extend the existing resident parking places outside No 20 Parsifal Road by 3 metres in length, outside No 2 Ingham Road by 5 metres, outside Hillfield Road by 0.8 metres in length, in Gondar Gardens by 19 metres, outside No 1 Lyncroft Gardens by 5 metres and adjacent to No 62 Burrard Road by 10 metres;

To introduce a new resident parking places on the north side of Glastonbury Road;

To swap and relocate the existing resident parking place with Loading bay in Ravenshaw Street;

To introduce new pay & display parking place in Dennington Park Road;

To reduce the existing resident parking places in Glenbrook Road and Mill Lane, by 3 metres and convert that space to motorcycle parking place;

To reduce the existing pay & display parking place in Inglewood Road, by 9 metres and convert that space to a disabled persons and motorcycle parking places;

To reduce the length of an existing resident bay by 1.5 metres outside No 62 Holmdale Road;

To convert existing resident space to shared-use parking place in Weech Road, corner with and outside 108 Fortune Green Road;

To convert part of existing resident space to introduce a new disabled persons parking place outside 102-109 Cholmley Gardens, Fortune Green Road;

To introduce double yellow lines "at any time" waiting restrictions at the following junctions within the (CA-P) Controlled Parking Zone;
