TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (City of Derby) (No 1) Order 2005". The order comes into operation on 24 October 2005 and extinguishes any right which persons have to use vehicles on a length of highway at Sinfin Moor Lane, Chellaston, Derby, measuring approximately 380 metres from the western boundary of No 79 Sinfin Moor Lane to approximately 85 metres east of the western boundary of The Bungalow, Sinfin Moor Lane.
