**THE A57/A628/A616 HYDE TO M1 TRUNK ROAD (A57/A628 MOTTRAM TO TINTWISTLE BYPASS) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER (NO MP ) 200**

**COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND AND NEW RIGHTS IN THE DISTRICT OF TAMESIDE AND IN THE DISTRICT OF HIGH PEAK IN THE COUNTY OF DERBYSHIRE**

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has prepared in draft the A57/A628/A616 Hyde to M1 Trunk Road (A57/A628 Mottram to Tintwistle Bypass) Compulsory Purchase Order (MP No ), 200 under Sections 239, 240, 246 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980. He is about to make this Order, and if made, the Order will authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights described below for the purpose of:

- (i) the construction of the new trunk road at Longdendale in the district of Tameside and in the Parish of Tintwistle in the district of High Peak in the County of Derbyshire in pursuance of the A57/A628/A616 Hyde to M1 Trunk Road (A57/A628 Mottram to Tintwistle Bypass) Order 200 ;
- (ii) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in those parishes and districts in pursuance of the A57/A628/A616 Hyde to M1 Trunk Road (A57/A628 Mottram to Tintwistle Bypass) (Side Roads) Order 200 ;
- (iii) the improvement of the Trunk Road in those parishes and districts;
- (iv) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road, the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;
- (v) use by the Secretary of State for Transport in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and
- (vi) the mitigation of any adverse effects which the existence or use of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved will have on their surroundings.

Copies of the draft Order and of the map referred to therein, together with copies of the published drafts of the above-mentioned Trunk Road Order and Side Roads Orders along with the detrunking Order, have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours from 31st January 2006 at the offices of:

Any objection to the draft compulsory purchase order must be made in writing and addressed to the Secretary of State at the offices of the Highways Agency, Room 710, City Tower, Piccadilly Plaza, Piccadilly, Manchester M1 4BE to arrive before 5 May 2006 and should state the title of the Order and quote Ref HA 65/9/336. It should give the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of the grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

### New Roads and Street Works

#### City of Southampton

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58

NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL ROAD WORKS

Southampton City Council under the above section gives the following details:

1. Three months advance notice is hereby given that Southampton City Council intends to carry out substantial road works.
2. The street/roads in which these works will take place are London Road, Carlton Crescent, Carlton Place and Vernon Walk.
3. Work is expected to affect the carriageway and footways of London Road, from a point 155 metres north of its junction with Brunswick Place, to a point 100 metres south of its junction with The Avenue; Carlton Crescent, from its junction with London Road to a point 170 metres west of its junction with London Road; Carlton Place, from its junction with Carlton Crescent to its junction with Winchester Street and Vernon Walk, for its entire length.
4. Work is expected to commence on 2 May 2006 (or should commence within one month of this date).
5. The works notified consist of carriageway and/or footway resurfacing.
6. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5, without the consent of the said Highway Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
