Take notice that due to the threat of a serious deficiency in supplies of water in the area which includes the Medway towns and extends from Northfleet in the West to Sittingbourne in the East and extends South to the top of the North Downs, caused by an exceptional shortage of rainfall, Southern Water Services Limited ("Southern Water") of Southern House, Yeoman Road, Worthing, West Sussex BN13 3NX, has been granted a drought permit by the Environment Agency under section 79A of the Water Resources Act 1991.

Southern Water is licensed to abstract water from the River Teise at Smallbridge, the River Medway at Yalding and Springfield, and at Bewl Water Reservoir, under Licence 02/114 dated 2 April 1992 ("the Licence"). Under the terms of the Licence, Southern Water is allowed to abstract a maximum quantity of 250 Megalitres per day (Ml/d) at Yalding and 136 Ml/d per day at Springfield subject to a Minimum Residual Flow ("MRF") of 275 Ml/d as measured at Teston weir.

The drought permit amends the Licence to reduce the MRF from 275 Ml/d to 100 Ml/d for the period from 24 January 2006 to 31 March 2006, which will allow Southern Water to continue to abstract water at the lower MRF in the river Medway. As Southern Water has facilities to pump water abstracted at Yalding to Bewl Water Reservoir, the drought permit will assist in the refill of Bewl Water Reservoir which is currently heavily depleted. The Environment Agency has issued the drought permit subject to conditions to appropriately mitigate any environmental effects of the drought permit. The drought permit will expire on 31 March 2006.
