THE CITY OF SUNDERLAND (ATHENAEUM STREET AREA) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2006

The Council of the City of Sunderland ("the Council") hereby gives notice that it made an Order on the 23rd June 2006 under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (1) Close the carriageway on Athenaeum Street between its junctions with Foyle Street and East Back Frederick Street, Sunderland.
- (2) Close the footway on the north side of Athenaeum Street between West Sunnyside and East Back Frederick Street and the footway on the west side of West Sunnyside from Athenaeum Street northwards for a distance of 28 metres.
- (3) Prohibit traffic on that section of East Back Frederick Street from its junction with Athenaeum Street northwards for a distance of 47 metres.
- (4) Reverse the one-way system southbound on East Back Frederick Street between Athenaeum Street and Borough Road, to northbound.

This will require the temporary suspension of Item 19 of Schedule 12 to the City of Sunderland (South Sunderland Area) (Prescribed Routes) Consolidation Order 2003.

The Order, required because works are proposed to be executed on or near the roads namely the demolition of the Manor Hotel, refurbishment of adjacent buildings and construction of a new property to be known as "The Place" will come into force on 26 June 2006. The Council is satisfied that the execution of the works will take longer than 18 months due to the scale of the project. It is anticipated that the works will continue for 24 months.

There will be an exception in the Order (apart from the provision relating to the reversal of the one-way system) for vehicles and personnel engaged in the works.

The prohibitions and restrictions, which will be on a rolling programme, will apply at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by the display of traffic signs. An alternative route for pedestrians will be available in Athenaeum Street via the southerly pavement between Foyle Street and East Back Frederick Street and in West Sunnyside via the footway on the opposite side of the road.

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58 NOTIFICATION OF SUBSTANTIAL WORKS FOR ROAD PURPOSES

1. Three months' advance notice is hereby given that Transport for London intends to carry out substantial works for road purposes.
 2. The road in which these works will take place is A217 St Dunstan's Hill (between Church Hill Road, and Abbots Road), Sutton.
 3. TfL Ref SPST-TO-S58/2006/021.
 4. Work is expected to affect the footway.
 5. Work is expected to commence on 2 October 2006.
 6. Work is expected to be completed on 1 December 2006.
 7. The works will include the following: major works, footway resurfacing and kerb repairs, cycle track facilities and street lighting.
 8. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 7 without consent of Transport for London, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58 NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL WORKS FOR ROAD PURPOSES

1. Three months' advance notice is hereby given that Transport for London intends to carry out substantial works for road maintenance purposes.
2. The road in which these works will take place is the A11 Mile End Road on the westbound carriageway from Burdett Road to White Horse Lane in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.
3. TfL Ref SPST-TO-S58/2006/020.
4. Work is expected to affect the carriageway.
5. Work is expected to commence on Friday 6 October 2006.
6. Work is expected to be completed on Sunday 8 October 2006.
7. The works notified will include the following: resurfacing of the westbound carriageway on the A11 Mile End Road from Burdett Road to White Horse Lane.
8. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 7 without consent of Transport for London, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
