NE of His Majesty's Messengers, sent Express by the Earl of Stair, His Majefty's Ambaffadour at the Court of France, arrived here this Evening, who left Paris the 24th Inftant, and has brought the welcome News of the King of Spain's Accession to the Quadruple Alliance without any Exception or Alteration. The Instruments of which Acceffion, under the Hand and Seal of his Catholick Majesty, bearing Date at Madrid the 26th Instant, N.S. have been transmitted to France, and Authentick Copies thereof are fent hither. A Ceffation of Arms between the Allies and Spain was immediately to follow, and a Congress will fhortly be appointed to conclude this happy Work, by Signing in Form the Treaties of Peace between the feveral Powers concerned in this War.
