THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (C186 BILSINGTON CANAL BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) NO 2 ORDER 2005

THE SECRETARY OF STATE for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the above Order which was made by Kent County Council under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to

- (a) construct new highways;
- (b) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- (c) provide new means of access to premises;

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the C186 Bilsington to Newchurch classified road and the Bilsington canal bridge which the Council are proposing to improve from a point 20 metres north of the Royal Military Canal to a point 25 metres south of the Royal Military Canal at Bilsington, in the District of Ashford, Kent.

Copies of the above mentioned Order and of the plans referred to therein have been deposited and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge at the offices of the County Secretary, The Kent County Council, Sessions House, County Hall, Maidstone, Kent (Room 2.84), and at the office of the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Ashford Borough Council, Civic Centre, Tannery Lane, Ashford, Kent TN23 1PL, and at The White Horse Free House, The Cross, Bilsington, Ashford, Kent TN24 7JX during normal working hours.

ANY PERSON aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 7 March 2007, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
