BOSTON ROAD - PROPOSED SAFETY SCHEME WITH WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND AMENDMENT TO ZEBRA CROSSING

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO.) ORDER 200*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order would be to introduce:-

(a) new or change existing waiting restrictions to double yellow line waiting restrictions which would apply at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) Single yellow line waiting restrictions applying between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays in the length of Boston Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

3. IT IS ALSO PROPOSED under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to relocate the zebra crossing immediately south of Oaklands Road southwards by approximately 26 metres to outside No. 183 Boston Road.

4. The Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order and the zebra crossing changes are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Parkman, 22-24 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London, W5 2BP, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Order is made or the Council decides not to make the Order.
