2. In brief, the general effect of the Orders would be to:-

(a) provide limited time free parking places in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice which may be used between 7 am and 4 pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a maximum period of 30 minutes, with no return to the parking place within 2 hours of leaving it;

(b) provide a limited time free parking place in Brailsford Road, on the north-west side, from a point 6.5 metres north-east of Tulse Hill north-eastward for a distance of 11.5 metres which may be used between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a maximum period of 30 minutes, with no return to the parking place within 2 hours of leaving it;

(c) provide a loading bay in Tulse Hill outside Nos. 13 to 19 Tulse Hill which may be used between 7 am and 4 pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for the purpose of loading or unloading vehicles for maximum periods of 30 minutes, with no return to the loading bay within 2 hours of leaving it;

(d) make changes to the waiting and loading restrictions in the length of Brailsford Road referred to above and the lengths of Tulse Hill specified in the Schedule to this Notice to enable the limited time free parking places and the loading bay to be introduced.

3. The measures described above are necessary to assist in regulating parking whilst encouraging a turnover for trade and shops in the area.

BUCKINGHAM ROAD, HAMPTON (REFERENCE 11/07)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames on the 26 February 2007 made the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the Order is to:—

(a) alter the two existing "school keep clear" zig-zag markings outside Buckingham Primary School (situated in Buckingham Road, Hampton between its junctions with Dean Road and Hanworth Close) such that they extend for an overall length of 75 metres and include the gap of approximately 12 metres which currently exists between the two clearways; and

(b) alter their hours of control from "no stopping between 8am and 9.30am and between 2.30pm and 4.00pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive" to "no stopping between 8am to 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive".

3. Copies of this Order, which will come into operation on 12 March 2007, a plan showing the location and effect of the Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 11/07, at:—
