**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14** 

THE M62 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 7- 6 EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND CARRIAGEWAYS) AND THE M57 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 2 – 1 SOUTHBOUND AND NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAYS) AND THE M62 MOTORWAY JUNCTION 6 (M57 JUNCTION 1) ENTRY AND EXIT SLIP ROADS (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2007

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the M62 and M57 Motorways in the Borough of Knowsley in the Merseyside area to enable junction

improvement works on the M62 Motorway at Junction 6 to be carried out in safety.

Work is expected to start at 0001 hours on Monday 16 April 2007 and is expected to be completed by 2359 hours on Sunday 30 November 2008.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on the M62 Motorway at the following locations:

- (i) on the westbound and eastbound carriageways between Junctions 7 and 6, for a distance of 1.8 kilometres;
- (ii) on the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the M62 Motorway at Junction 6;
- (iii) on the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the M62 Motorway at Junction 6.

The effect of the Order will also be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on the M57 Motorway at the following locations:

- (i) on the southbound and northbound carriageways between Junctions 2 and 1, for a distance of 2.7 kilometres;
- (ii) on the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M57 Motorway at Junction 6 of the M62 Motorway (M57/Junction 1);
- (iii) on the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M57 Motorway at Junction 6 of the M62 Motorway (M57/Junction 1).
