### Road Traffic Acts

#### London Borough of Camden

##### THE CAMDEN (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (BELSIZE AREAS) TRAFFIC ORDER 2007

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that the Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a maximum speed limit of 20 mph (miles per hour) for any motor vehicles travelling in all the streets mentioned in the Schedule to this notice.

#### SCHEDULE

##### ZONE 1:

AKENSIDE ROAD; BAYNES MEWS; BELSIZE CRESCENT; BELSIZE LANE; BELSIZE PARK MEWS; BELSIZE PLACE; DALEHAM GARDENS; DALEHAM MEWS; LYNDHURST GARDENS; NUTLEY TERRACE, between Fitzjohn's Avenue and Daleham Gardens; ORNAN ROAD; PERCEVAL AVENUE; PRINCESS MEWS; WEDDERBURN ROAD.

##### ZONE 2:
