THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL SPEED LIMIT REVIEW (VARIOUS ROADS, VARIOUS PARISHES IN AREA 8) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The

effect of the Order will be to impose a 30 miles per hour speed restriction on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.
