THE BEXLEY (FREE PARKING PLACES) (DISABLED PERSONS) (NO.1) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2007

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley, have made the above titled Traffic Order on the 1st October 2007 under Sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to consolidate and bring into one Order all the disabled persons' parking places in the London Borough of Bexley and the provisions which regulate the use of those parking places, without changing anything with regard to the dimensions or locations of those parking places on street.
3. A copy of the Order, of any related Orders and a Statement of Reasons for making the Order will be available for inspection for a period of 6 weeks from the date of the making of the Order at the Contact Centre, Civic Offices, Broadway, Bexleyheath, Kent DA6 7LB between the hours of 9.00a.m. and 5.00p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order takes effect.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not made within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may make application for the purpose to the High Court before the expiration of 6 weeks from the date on which this Order is made.
