THE TOWER HAMLETS (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO 3) ORDER 2007

MADE: 7TH DECEMBER

COMING INTO OPERATION: 17TH DECEMBER

The Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 of the Local Government Act 1985(b) and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 17th December and may be cited as the Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Route) (No.3) Order 2007
2. In this Order, unless the content otherwise requires:—

“enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

“cycle path” means the area of carriageway in Old Montague Street in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, which lies to the south eastern side of the “median island” and extends 12 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Vallance Road.

“median island” means the island which lies adjacent to the south eastern kerb line of Old Montague Street just south west of the south western kerb line of Vallance Road in the said London Borough; and the expression “pedal cycle” has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(c).

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order:

- (a) The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Routes) (No 6) Traffic Order 1973 (d) is hereby revoked.
- (b) The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1970 (e) shall have effect as though for item in the Schedule to that Order numbered 3(ii) there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

3. No person causing any vehicle to proceed in Greatorex Street in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets shall thereupon cause that vehicle to enter that length of Old Montague Street which lies south-west of Greatorex Street.

4. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Greatorex Street in the said London Borough which lies between the north-western kerb line of Whitechapel Road and the south-eastern kerb line of Old Montague Street in a direction other than from south-east to north-west.

5. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of Old Montague Street in the said London Borough which lies between the north-eastern kerb line of Greatorex Street and the south-western kerb line of Vallance Road and in a direction other than from south-west to north-east.

6. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of carriageway which lies to the north-west of the median island in Old Montague Street in a direction other than from south-west to north-east.

7. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the cycle path.

8. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall apply to a pedal cycle proceeding in a south west direction.

9. Nothing in Articles 3 to 6 of this order shall apply:—

- (a) in relation to any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in an emergency;
- (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform; or
- (c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

London Borough of Tower Hamlets**THE TOWER HAMLETS (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO.3) TRAFFIC ORDER 2007**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets on 7th December 2007 made the above-mentioned Order under Section 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991) and in accordance with the provisions of regulation 23 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, the above made Order will continue in force indefinitely the provisions of The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Route) (No.3) Traffic Order 2007.

2. The general effect of The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Route) (No.3) Order 2007 will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in;

- (i) Greatorex Street in a south west direction
- (ii) Davenant Street in a south west direction.
- (iii) Old Montague Street in a south west direction except for pedal cycles in the area which lies to the south eastern side of the “median island” and extends 12 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Vallance Road

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 17th December 2006, can be inspected by appointment during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, at the offices of Environment and Culture, Transportation and Highways Section, Anchorage House c/o Mulberry Place, London E14

4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision provided therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks of the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
