WARWICK LANE – LOADING RESTRICTIONS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London on 4 January 2008 made an order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, so as to continue indefinitely the provisions of an experimental scheme.

2. The effect of the Order will be to continue indefinitely the provisions of the City of London (Warwick Lane) Experimental Order 2006, which prohibited waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle at certain times in lengths of Warwick Lane.

3. A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 14 January 2008 a plan showing the affected street can be inspected during normal office hours until the end of six weeks from that date on which the order was made at the Department of Planning and Transportation, St. Alphage House, Fore Street, London EC2Y 5DA.

4. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the above address or by telephoning 0207 332 1108.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS CARNAC ROAD, CLIVE ROAD, MARTELL ROAD, MYTON ROAD AND TRITTON ROAD

(This notice is about the Council's proposal to introduce new at any time waiting restrictions and to make changes to existing waiting and loading restrictions in the lengths of roads specified in the schedules to this notice. Objections may be made – see paragraph 7)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lambeth Borough Council propose to make the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. **) Order 2008 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. In brief, the general effect of the Orders would be to:—

(a) ban waiting by vehicles at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice (exemptions would apply for vehicles waiting for loading and unloading purposes, subject to certain conditions and time limits);

(b) ban waiting by vehicles between 7am and 4 pm Mondays to Fridays in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

3. Any existing bans on waiting by vehicles in the lengths of streets specified in paragraph 2 above would be revoked.

4. The bans are necessary to prevent parking which obstructs access for emergency services vehicles and refuse collection vehicles and hinders the free flow of traffic.

weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made, or as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders at the offices of Lambeth Borough Council's Transport and Highways Group, 3rd Floor, Blue Star House, 234-244 Stockwell Road, Brixton, London SW9 9SP.

All objections and other representations relating to the proposed Orders must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and should be sent to Barbara Poulter, Transport and Highways, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Blue Star House, 234-244 Stockwell Road, Brixton, London SW9 9SP, by 29th January 2008. Any objection may be communicated to, or be seen by, other persons who may have an interest in this matter.

SCHEDULE 1

CARNAC STREET, between the south-western kerb-line of Clive Road and a point 5 metres south-west of that kerb-line.

CLIVE ROAD, the south-west side, between a point 5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Carnac Street and a point 5 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Carnac Street.

MARTELL ROAD, (a) between the south-eastern kerb-line of Park Hall Road and a point 5 metres south-east of that kerb-line; (b) the north-east side, (i) between a point 5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Myton Road and a point 7.5 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb-line of Myton Road.

MYTON ROAD, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Martell Road and a point 5 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

PARK HALL ROAD, the south-east side, between a point 5 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Martell Road and a point 5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Martell Road.

SCHEDULE 2

MARTELL ROAD, (a) the north-east side, between the northern kerb-line of Tritton Road and a point 5 metres north-west of Tritton Road; and (b) the south-west side between a point 3.1 metres south-east of the south-eastern flank wall of No. 58 Martell Road and a point 4.5 metres north-west of the party wall of Nos. 56 and 58 Martell Road.

TRITTON ROAD, (a) the north side, between the north-eastern kerb-line of Martell Road and a point 5 metres east of that kerb-line; (b) the south side, between the party wall of Nos. 52 and 54 Tritton Road and a point 400 millimetres west of the party wall of Nos. 56 and 58 Tritton Road.
