THE CROYDON (GOODS VEHICLES) (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 1) TRAFFIC ORDER 2002 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) TRAFFIC ORDER 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on the 10 March 2008 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act, 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the Order would be:-

(a) to designate a free parking place in Fairholme Road, Croydon, the south-east side, from a point 15.00 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of London Road south-westward for a distance of 10.00 metres.

(b) to provide that the parking place would be in operation between the hours of 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

(c) to specify that the use of the parking place would be restricted to goods vehicles only for the purpose of loading or unloading goods or delivering or collecting goods from premises adjacent to the parking places;

(d) to restrict to 30 minutes any one period of waiting in the parking place and to prohibit the return to the same parking place of the same vehicle for a period of one hour;

(e) to provide that the parking place may be suspended when necessary to facilitate the carrying out of certain functions such as building or street works, furniture removals, funerals, etc.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 17 March 2008 (and of any Orders which has previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made at the Enquiry Counter, "One Stop" Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the

relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
