THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (PARKING PLACES, ZONE "B/C") (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 200*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham propose to make the above-mentioned Order under the powers granted by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

(b) Revoking sections of parking places in Masbro Road, Blythe Road, Minford Gardens, Dewhurst Road, Sterndale Road, Batoum Gardens, Dunsany Road.

THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (CONSOLIDATION) AMENDMENT (NO. 27) ORDER 200*

1. ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (FOOTBALL STADIUMS' ROAD CLOSURES) ORDER (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2008

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham on 23rd April 2008 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, 122 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the above Order will be to amend the Hammersmith and Fulham (Football Stadiums' Road Closures) Order (No. 1) 2002 so as to insert the following public highways:-

(a) Bagley's Lane, between its junctions with Townmead Road and Fulmead Street;

(b) Fulmead Street, (a) the north-west side, (b) the south-west side, between its junction with Bagley's Lane and a point 9.70 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of Nos. 15 to 22 Shaftsbury Court, Maltings Place.
