1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, in connection with the implementation of Southall (Area 5) controlled parking zone LL, on the 18th June 2008 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Ealing (Southall Area 5) (Residents Parking Places) Order 2008 will be:

(a) to introduce parking places for the use by residents, their visitors and business users in lengths of Adelaide Road, Albert Road, Clifton Road, Ellison Gardens, Endsleigh Road, Florence Road, George Street, Lea Road, Leonard Road, Montague Road, Norwood Gardens, Regina Road (between Montague Way and George Street/Recreation Road) Talbot Road, Williams Road and Witley Gardens;

(b) to provide that the parking places will operate between the hours of 8.30 am and 6 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and 2 pm and 6 pm on Sundays (the controlled hours);

(c) to provide that passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles may be left in a parking place without limitation on time during the controlled hours and that with the exception of motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles, a valid LL zone permit or voucher must be displayed whilst parked therein.

3. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 99) Order 2008 will be to introduce limited time free parking places where parking by vehicles during the controlled hours will be limited to a maximum stay of 1 hour with no return by the same vehicle to the same parking place for a period of one hour in Adelaide Road, Clifton Road, Florence Road and Regina Road. Existing free parking places in Albert Road, Leonard Road will have their maximum stay increased from 30 minutes to 1 hour and their hours of operation reduced to the controlled hours of the new zone.

4. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Loading Places) (Amendment No. 42) Order 2008 will be to amend the operating time of the existing loading bay in Albert Road.

5. The general effect of the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 352) Order 2008 will be to amend existing waiting restrictions or introduce new waiting restrictions that apply at any time or between the controlled hours in lengths of Adelaide Road, Albert Road, Clifton Road, Ellison Gardens, Endsleigh Road, Florence Road, George Street, Lea Road, Leonard Road, Montague Road, Norwood Gardens, Regina Road, Talbot Road, Williams Road and Witley Gardens and in an adjacent length of Inverness Road.

6. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (Amendment No. 83) Order 2008 will be to introduce free parking places for vehicles displaying a disabled person's blue badge parking permit without limit on time in certain lengths of Adelaide Road, Albert Road, Clifton Road, Ellison Gardens, Endsleigh Road, Florence Road, George Street, Lea Road, Leonard Road, Montague Road, Regina Road, Williams Road and Witley Gardens.

7. Business Parking Permits will be available at a cost of £250 per annum and Residents Parking Permits at a cost of £45 per annum.

8. Business Visitors Vouchers will be available at a cost of £1 per hour and Residents Visitors Vouchers will be available at a cost of 40p for a period of up to 3 hours and £1 all day. Borough wide vouchers will be available to park in the zone for £1 per hour.

9. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on the 23rd June 2008 and of other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, can be inspected between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday

to Fridays inclusive until the 30th July 2008 at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST.

10. Any person desiring to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to any of the Orders may make application for the purpose to the High Court by the 30th July 2008.

CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE

(REFERENCE 53/08)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the London Borough of Hounslow, on 16 June 2008 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the Orders is to:-

(a) vary the hours during which the parking controls in the Twickenham stadium event zone may be in force on any event day such that they may start no sooner than 7am and end no later than 11pm; and

(b) stipulate that the parking controls should remain in force for a maximum of 12 hours in any one event day.

3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 23 June 2008, a plan showing the location and effect of the Orders and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders can be inspected for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice, quoting Reference 53/08, at:-

(d) the Forms and Documents Counter of the Access Hounslow Main Reception Area, Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow, TW3 4DN between 8.45am-5pm, Mondays to Thursdays and 8.45am-4.45pm on Fridays; and

(e) the Richmond upon Thames Civic Centre (Ground floor, planning reception), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am-5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays.

5.
