Paris, September 4. BY Letters from Sardinia we have received a particular Account, that Admiral Byng arri-ving there on the 22d of July, tound the Pie-montele Troops transported from Sicily were landed at Cagliari ; but the Prince d'Ottajaho the Empe-rour's Minister not being come, they could not then be put into Possession of the Island. On the 31st the Prince d'Ottajano arrived, and Conterences being held with Sig Chacon Captain-General of the Spa-nith Troops, the following Articles were fettled.

Articles agreed between their Excellencies the Prince d'Ottajano his Imperial Majetty's Commiffary Minister and Plenipotentiary, Sir George B/ng Admiral and Commander in Chief of His Bri-tannick Majefty's Fleet and his Plenipotentiary, and Sig. Chacon his Catholick Majefty's General and Plenipocentiary.

1. It is agreed, that this Day and To-Morrow the Spanish Infantry, which is to evacuate Cagliari, shall imbark; and that on Sunday next in the Morning his Excellency Sig. Chacon shall deliver the Poss-fession of the Cattle to his Excellency the Prince d'Ottajano, with all the Registers and other Wri-tings belonging to the Kingdom of Sardinia; and that he shall this Day issued orders to all the Gover-nours of the Places of the Kingdom, to deliver the faid Places to the Officers who shall produce his Excellency the Prince d'Ottajano's Orders. 2. As the Spaniards are obliged by the feveral Treaties to deliver up the Artillery, Ammunicion, and Provisions of the Places of the Kingdom of Sag-dinia, in the fame State as they were found when the Spaniards took the faid Kingdom, it is agreed 1. On the 5th the Prince d'Ottajano was put into Possession of Cagliari and of the rest of the Island; and on the 8th he delivered it up to the King of Sardinia's Commiflary.
