### London Borough of Lambeth

#### PROPOSAL TO DESIGNATE NEW DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES AND REVOKE EXISTING DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES

(Note: This notice is about the Council's proposal to designate new disabled persons' parking places in certain roads in the borough and to remove certain disabled persons' parking places that are no longer required in the borough. Objections may be made – see paragraph 6)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. \*\*) Order 2008 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. In brief, the general effect of the Order would be:-

(a) to designate new disabled persons' parking places on the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) to revoke disabled persons' parking places on the streets specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

3. The parking places referred to in paragraph 2(a) above would operate at any time and would be available for use only by vehicles which display in the relevant position a valid disabled persons' blue badge issued by a local authority.

#### CLOSURE OF BYRON WAY AT ITS JUNCTION WITH WAYFARER ROAD

#### THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO. \*) TRAFFIC ORDER 200\*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing propose, to make the above mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to close Byron Road to all vehicles at its junction with Wayfarer Road.
