- (c) introduce waiting restrictions operating "at any time" into a section of Riversdale Road surrounding the width restriction.

- (c) introduce 3 new loading bays operating Monday to Friday 8.30am to 6.30pm and Saturday 8.30am to 1.30pm; one in a certain section Finsbury Market and two in certain sections of Earl Street;
- (d) remove an existing motor cycle bay from a certain section of Clifton Street;
- (e) introduce a pedal cycle stand onto a certain section of the footway of Pindar Street.
