BARTHOLOMEW CLOSE – RELOCATION AND DESIGNATION OF DISABLED PERSON'S PARKING BAYS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London propose to make an order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under Section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highway (South East) (No.3) Order 2009" authorising the stopping up of an irregular-shaped north eastern part width of Leighton Road, comprising unnamed service road and highway verge commencing from its junction with Ivy Lane, extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of 175 metres and having a maximum width of 40 metres, at Soulbury in the District of Aylesbury Vale to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to The JS Design Partnership and S and N Pub Enterprises by Aylesbury Vale District Council on 30 August 2007 under reference 07/00806/APP. ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY THE ORDER and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 17 February 2009 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
