TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - KNOCKHUNDRED LANE, BRAMSHOTT CHASE

Notice is hereby given that Hampshire County Council has made an order to allow for construction works of more than eighteen months duration to be undertaken on the A3 Portsmouth Road and Knockhundred Lane as follows:

ROAD TO BE CLOSED: That part of Knockhundred Lane between its junction with A3 Portsmouth Road and a point 115 metres south-east of that junction.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: From the south-eastern point of closure, south-east via Knockhundred Lane to its junction with Hammer Lane; north via Hammer Lane to its junction with A3 Portsmouth Road; further directions will be indicated by signs on the diversion route.

PERIOD OF CLOSURE: From 27 March 2009 until completion of the works. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than twenty-one months).

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A62 TRUNK ROAD (GILDERSOME INTERCHANGE NORTHERN & SOUTHERN ROUNDABOUTS AND THE CONNECTING LENGTH OF GELDERD ROAD) (30 MILES PER HOUR SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under 83(1) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A62 Trunk Road in the Districts of Leeds and Kirklees, which comes into force on Tuesday 31 March 2009.

The effect of the Order is as described in issue number 58909 of the London Gazette dated 11 December 2008 (ref: 685040).
