THE CROYDON (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) TRAFFIC ORDER 2009

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council on the 18 May 2009 made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 32, 35, 124 of, and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act, 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
