THE GREENWICH (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 200*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Greenwich Borough Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions at the junction of **Titmuss Avenue** and **Bentham Road** extending north-westward into Titmuss Avenue for a distance of 43 metres on its north-east side and 53 metres on its south-west side.
