VARIOUS WAITING RESTRICTIONS AROUND HOUNSLOW BOROUGH

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.\*\*) ORDER 20\*\*

- 1. **Notice is hereby given** that the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
- 2. The general effect of the amendment Order would be to further amend the London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2008 so that:
- (i) waiting by vehicles would be prohibited in the lengths of roads as specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 to this Notice;
- (ii) to revoke existing waiting and loading restrictions in the length of road as specified in Schedule 7 to this Notice; and
- (iii) to incorporate a drafting amendment for item number 250 in Schedules 1 and item number 38 in Schedule 2 of the 2008 Order so that they now correctly read Granville Avenue, Hounslow as was originally intended instead of Granville Avenue, Feltham.
- 3. A copy of; the proposed Order; the above-mentioned Order of 2008; the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order; a map which indicates the lengths of roads to which the Order relates can be inspected online at www.hounslow.gov.uk and at the Forms and Documents Counter in the reception of the Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow TW3 4DN between the hours of 9am and 4.15pm Mondays to Fridays, until the end of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published.

SCHEDULE 1

(Proposed "at any time" waiting restrictions)

Atcham Road, Hounslow

(a) both sides, from the south-eastern kerb-line of Heath Road to a point 8.0 metres south-east of that kerb-line.

Avenue Road, Feltham

(a) west side, from the north-eastern kerb-line of Bedfont Road to a point 32.2 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

Bedfont Road, Feltham

(a) north-east side, from the western kerb-line of Avenue Road to the eastern kerb-line of Raleigh Road.

Burlington Lane, Chiswick

(a) south side, from a point 4.5 metres west of the western wall of No. 85 Burlington Lane, eastwards for a distance of 48.0 metres

Heath Road, Hounslow

(a) south-west side, from a point 10.0 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Atcham Road, south-westwards to the boundary wall of Nos. 109/111 Heath Road

Lingwood Gardens, Isleworth

(a) both sides, from the north-eastern kerb-line of Ridgeway Road North to a point 11.0 metres north-east of that kerb-line.

Mauveine Gardens, Hounslow

(a) between the south-western kerb-line of Williams Drive south-westwards for a distance of 7.0 metres
