## Warrants Under the Royal Sign Manual

The Supreme Court of the United Kingdom was established pursuant to the provisions of the Constitutional Reform Act 2005 with effect from 1 October 2009 and provides for there to be offices of President of the Supreme Court, Deputy President of the Supreme Court and a number of Justices of the Supreme Court.

The QUEEN has been pleased by Royal Warrant bearing date 1 October 2009 to declare the rank and precedence of the President of the Supreme Court shall be placed in order immediately after the Lord Speaker and the rank and precedence of the Deputy President of the Supreme Court shall be placed in order immediately after the Master of the Rolls and the rank and precedence of the office of Justice of the Supreme Court shall be placed in order immediately after the Deputy President of the Supreme Court.

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### THE A40 TRUNK ROAD (HUNTLEY, GLOUCESTERSHIRE) (RESTRICTION) ORDER 2003 (VARIATION) ORDER 200\_

The Secretary of State for Transport gives notice that he intends to make an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A40 Trunk Road in Huntley in the District of The Forest of Dean, in the County of Gloucestershire.

The effect of the Order would be to vary the A40 Trunk Road (Huntley, Gloucestershire) (Restriction) Order 2003 by lengthening the eastern termination point by 35 metres.

A Variation Order is also being made simultaneously to reduce the current 50mph speed limit order by 35 metres.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal, a copy of the order to be varied and a Statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during opening hours at Huntley Post Office, High Street, Huntley, Gloucester, GL19 3DS and at General Garages, Main Road,
