THE BROMLEY (BUS LANES) (NO.1) ORDER 1998 (AMENDMENT NO. 9) ORDER 2009

THE BROMLEY (LOADING BAYS) (TIME RESTRICTED) ORDER 1996 (AMENDMENT NO. 26) ORDER 2009

(CRAY AVENUE, ORPINGTON; AUGUSTUS LANE, ORPINGTON)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 9th October 2009 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 19th October 2009.

The effect of the Orders would be to:—

- (a) amend the hours of operation of the bus lane in Cray Avenue and Sevenoaks Way, Orpington as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (b) introduce a new loading bay as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

CRAY AVENUE, Orpington, the west side, from a point 160m north of the northern kerbline of Poverest Road to its junction with Sevenoaks Way.

SEVENOAKS WAY, Orpington, the west side, from its junction with Cray Avenue to the southern kerbline of Millfields Close.

LOADING BAY

Loading Bay – At Any Time – 2 hours waiting time, no return within 1 hour – Goods Vehicles:—

AUGUSTUS LANE, Orpington the west side, from a point 79m north of the northern kerbline of Station Road northwards for a distance of 16.5m.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield on 12 October 2009 made the Enfield (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 2) Order 2009 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) designate disabled persons' parking places in the streets specified in the first paragraph of the heading to this Notice in which disabled persons' vehicles which display a valid disabled person's badge ("Blue Badge") in the relevant position, issued by any local authority, may be left therein (**Note:** in the case of Albany Road there will be a maximum stay of 3 hours);
- (b) remove certain disabled persons' parking places in the streets specified in the second paragraph of the heading to this Notice, which are no longer required.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 21 November 2009 and other relevant documents can be inspected at the Reception Desk, "B" Block, the Civic Centre, Silver Street, Enfield, Middlesex, EN1 3XD during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
