PROPOSED CYCLE EXEMPTION

THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO.***) TRAFFIC ORDER 200*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to revoke and re-enact the provisions of the Ealing (Prescribed Routes) (No.43) Traffic Order 2001 that impose one way working in a south-west to north-east direction in Featherstone Road (between the common boundary of Nos. 127 and 129 Featherstone Road and its junction with Dudley Road) so as to allow pedal cycles to enter Featherstone Road through the cycle by pass to be constructed south-west of the south-western kerb-line of the east to west arm of Featherstone Road and to then continue in a south-westerly direction in Featherstone Road in the advisory contra flow cycle lane to be marked on the road.

3. The Order, and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either of the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49, 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended subject to the consent of the London Borough of Hounslow in respect of North Hyde Lane.

2. The general effect of the Speed Limit Order would be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in Adelaide Road, Albert Road, Belmont Avenue, Beverley Road, Church Avenue, Church Road, Clifton Road, Dagmar Road, Ellison Gardens, Endsleigh Road, Florence Road, George Street, Gordon Road, Grosvenor Road, Hammond Road, Havelock Road (King Street to Merrick Road), Hortus Road, Inverness Road, King Street (part), Kingston Road, Lea Road, Leamington Road, Leonard Road, Manor Way, Marlow Road, Montague Road, Montague Way, North Hyde Lane (part), Norwood Gardens, Norwood Road (Merrick Road to King Street), Osterley Park Road, Portland Road, Recreation Road, Rectory Road, Regina Road, Rosamun Street, Salisbury Road, Stratford Road, Tachbrook Road, Talbot Road, The Common, Victoria Road, Witley Gardens, Williams Road and Windsor Road.

3. The general effect of the Stopping Outside Schools, the Residents Parking Place amendment and the Waiting Restriction Amendment Orders would be in Clifton Road to

(a) amend the school keep clear prohibitions to bring them into line with the markings on the ground;

(b) remove the parking place between the school keep clear markings and replace it with double yellow line waiting restrictions applying at any time and a length of parking outside Nos. 23 to 27 Clifton Road in connection with the provision of a raised table.

4. FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council under the powers of section 90c of the Highways Act 1980 propose to introduce:

(a) series of sinusoidal round top road humps each with a nominal height of 75 mms and longitudinal width of 3.70 metres in

(i) Hortus Road: outside No.13 and The Hall;

(ii) Kingston Road: outside Nos. 22 and 24 and outside Nos. 46 and 48;

(iii) Osterley Park Road: outside the Library and outside No.12;

(iv) Grosvenor Road: outside Nos.13 and 15;

(v) Marlow Road: outside Nos. 15 and 17;

(vi) Victoria Road: outside Nos. 37 and 39 and outside Nos. 14 and 16;

(vii) Rectory Road: outside Nos. 33 and 35 and outside Nos. 11 and 13;
