##### NOTICE OF DETERMINATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 105 B (1) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 (AS AMENDED)

The Secretary of State for the Department of Transport gives notice that he has determined that the proposal to install five new road signs on the London bound section of the A20 from the Port of Dover, 400m west of Western Heights Roundabout extending to Satmar Lane (at grid references: 631569, 140923 and 627841, 138946), a relevant project in accordance with section 105A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended), is not to be made subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment in accordance with Part VA of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) and EC Directive 85/337/EEC (as amended).

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

##### THE A40 TRUNK ROAD (OVER TO HIGHNAM, GLOUCESTERSHIRE) (BUS LANE, PROHIBITION OF USE OF GAPS IN CENTRAL RESERVATION AND PROHIBITION OF TURNS)

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1(1), 2(1) and (2), and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A40 Trunk Road in the City of Gloucester and the District of Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire.

THE EFFECT of the Order would authorise:

1. The prohibition of vehicles:

- (a) other than buses, taxis, bicycles and motorcycles from using the bus lane in the nearside (left hand) lane of the eastbound carriageway of the A40 Trunk Road between Highnam Roundabout and Over Roundabout from a point 24 metres west of its junction with the B4215 to a point 126.9 metres west of its junction with Horseshoe Drive;
- (b) turning right from the eastbound carriageway of the A40 into the agricultural access, situated 1427 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48, via the gap in the central reservation;
- (c) turning right from the westbound carriageway of the A40 into the access to Over Farm, situated 1427 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48, via the gap in the central reservation;
- (d) joining the A40 from Linton Farm, situated 402 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48, from proceeding in any direction other than leftwards; and
- (e) joining the A40 from Over Farm Shop, situated 1732 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48, from proceeding in any direction other than leftwards.

2. The closure of gaps in the central reservation situated:

- (a) 1842 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48; and
- (b) 1130 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A48.

Information provided in response to this consultation, including personal information, may be subject to publication or disclosure in accordance with the access to information regimes (these are primarily the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004).
