PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BEDFONT LANE CONTROLLED PARKING SCHEME

A. THE HOUNSLOW (BEDFONT LANE) (PARKING PLACES) (2009, NO. 29) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 20**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 45 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

2. It is necessary to amend the description of item no. 2 as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice, which designates a residents' parking place in the Traffic Order for the Bedfont Lane Parking Scheme to facilitate the provision of vehicle crossover at No. 115 Bedfont Lane, Feltham.

3. 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to:

(1) convert pay and display parking bays to cycle parking places (for the use of London Cycle Hire bicycles only), in the following locations:

(a) **Bramham Gardens (also known as Bolton Gardens)**, the north-west side, adjacent to Park House, No.227 Earl's Court Road (loss of 2 bays);

(b) **Gloucester Road**, the east side, adjacent to Campbell Court, opposite No. 96 Gloucester Road (loss of 3 bays);

(c) **Holbein Place**, the south-west side, adjacent to Nos. 2 to 6B Holbein Place (loss of 5 bays);

(d) **Knareborough Place**, the south-west side, adjacent to the Premier Inn Hotel, No. 11 Knareborough Place (loss of 3 bays);

(e) **Pembridge Gardens**, the east side, outside Nos. 1 to 3 Pembridge Gardens (loss of 3 bays); and

(2) convert residents' and pay and display parking space to cycle parking places (for the use of London Cycle Hire bicycles only) in the following locations:

(a) **Collingham Gardens (the north-east arm)**, the north-east side, opposite Nos. 2 and 3 Collingham Gardens (convert nearly 2 metres of double yellow lines, 2 pay and display bays and approximately 2 metres of residents' parking space with a loss of 2 pay and display bays);

(b) **Russell Road**, the south-west side, outside Nos. 1 to 18 Ibberton House, 70 Russell Road (convert 3 residents' parking spaces and approximately 3 metres of pay and display space to a cycle parking place and convert the adjacent pay and display bays to residents' parking space, with no loss of residents' parking provision in the area, but a loss of 4 pay and displays bays overall) [note: this replaces a similar proposal previously advertised in respect of this location].

3. London Cycle Hire docking stations are proposed in the above-mentioned cycle parking places and planning application details of these sites may be found on the Council's website at www.rbkc.gov.uk/planning.
