ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A36 TRUNK ROAD (BLACK DOG HILL, WARMINSTER, WILTSHIRE) (LAYBY CLOSURE) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2010

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT gives notice that he made this Order on 18 March 2010 on the A36 Trunk Road (A36) in the Wiltshire.

THE EFFECT of the Order is to close the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A36 situated 1620 metres north of the junction with the A3098 at Black Dog Hill, Warminster.

The Order, which is an experimental Order, will come into force on 6 April 2010 and remain in force for a period of not longer than eighteen months.

Traffic movements will be monitored throughout the experimental period and the Secretary of State will be considering in due course whether or not the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or, if the Order is subsequently varied by another Order under Section 9 or modified pursuant to Section 10 of the 1984 Act, from the coming into force of that variation or modification (whichever is the latest), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation. Any objections must be made in writing, clearly stating the grounds of objection, to the Project Sponsor, Dave Frampton, at the Highways Agency, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6HA.

A COPY of the made Experimental Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal and a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for making the Order may be inspected during opening hours at Westbury Library, Westbury House, Edward Street, Westbury BA13 3BD and at Warminster Library, Three Horseshoes Walk, Warminster BA12 9BT. They may also be obtained by application to the Highways Agency, Network Delivery and Development Directorate, Zone 2/06K, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol BS1 6HA, quoting reference HA 041/029/302.

ANY PERSON wishing to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any instrument under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks from 26 March 2010 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision contained therein.

Information provided in response to this consultation, including personal information, may be subject to publication or disclosure in accordance with the access to information regimes (these are primarily the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004).
