- 2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Order would be to:
- (a) impose waiting restrictions applying "at any time" in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) impose waiting restrictions applying 7am to 7pm on Mondays to Fridays in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; (c) impose waiting restrictions applying 8am to 9.30am and 3pm to 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.
- 3. The general effect of the Parking Place Order would be to provide free parking places in Campbell Road adjacent to Hanwell station which would be available at all times without time limit.
- 4. The general effect of the Disabled Persons Parking Place Order would be to introduce a free parking place for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit where such vehicles may be left without limit on time in Campbell Road adjacent to Hanwell Station. 5. The general effect of the Prescribed Route Order would be to close the gap in the island side dividing Greenford Avenue from Church Road which lies adjacent to No. 25 Church Road.
