PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO STOP AND SHOP PARKING IN CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE Z

THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 2010

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985. This replaces the notice given on 19th and 22nd March 2010 in respect of stop and shop limited time free parking bays.

2. The general effect of the Ealing (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) (Amendment No. *) Order 2010 would be to

(A) introduce additional limited stay free parking bays:

- (i) between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Boileau Road, on its south-west side, adjacent to No. 40 Corringway (two bays) maximum stay of one hour with no return to the parking place for one hour
- (ii) between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Vale Lane, on its south side, opposite Nos. 13/15 (three further bays) - maximum stay of two hours with no return to the parking place for one hour.
- (iii) operating between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Noel Road, on its south-east side, outside Nos.

215/217 (two bays), Saxon Drive, on its north-west side, outside No. 8 Station Parade (one further bay); and on its south-east side, opposite No. 154 Saxon Drive (two further bays) with maximum stay of thirty minutes with no return to the parking place for one hour;

(iv) operating between the hours of 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in Queens Drive, north side opposite and to the east of the Greystoke public house and Station Road, on its south side, near its junction with Queen's Drive (two further bays) with maximum stay of one hour with no return to the parking place for one hour

(B) reduce the maximum limit of stay at the existing free parking places in Noel Road, Saxon Drive and Station Parade in the vicinity of West Acton Station.

3. The Order, precise details concerning the lengths of roads affected and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order are available for inspection between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays inclusive at Mouchel Limited, 6th Floor, 58 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2ST, until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders is made or the Council decides not to make the Order.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 to implement changes in the West Ealing Home Zone controlled parking zone.

2. The general effect of the Ealing West Ealing Home Zone CPZ) (Residents and Business Parking Places (Amendment No. *) Order 2010 would be to provide further lengths of permit parking operating between the zone hours of 9.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in:

- (a) Hastings Road on its north-west side, outside Nos. 34 to 37 to increase the number of bays from 10 to 13;
- (b) Broughton Road, on its west side, opposite Nos. 37 to 39 Broughton Road to increase the number of bays from 3 to 5;
- (c) Broughton Road, on its east side, outside Nos. 34 to 36 Broughton Road to increase the number of angled bays from 5 to 6 and provide a relocated kerbside bay.

3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order would be:

- (a) to impose new restrictions or amend existing waiting restrictions to apply at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice and make minor adjustments to the restrictions applying in Broughton Road to accommodate the parking changes in paragraph 2 above;
- (b) impose restrictions on waiting applying between 8am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice and
- (c) remove the solo motorcycle parking place in Broughton Road.
