2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:-

- (a) change two existing general permit bays in Ardleigh Road to resident permit only parking bays;
- (b) extend a section of residents permit holders only bay replacing an existing section of waiting restrictions operating "at any time" in Ardleigh Road.
