

(a) introduce free parking places for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit where such vehicles may be left without limit on time in certain lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 1 and 2 to this notice;

(b) revoke free parking places for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit in certain lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice;

(c) amend existing permit parking places in those roads where the provision of the disabled parking place requires the removal of permit parking or where the removal of the disabled parking place enables additional permit parking to be provided.
