Warrants Under the Royal Sign Manual

The QUEEN has been graciously pleased by Warrant under Her Royal Signet and Sign Manual bearing date 23 March 2010 to give and grant unto Salisbury City Council Her Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority that it may bear and use the Arms and Supporters recorded for the corporation of the City of New Sarum at the Heralds' Visitations of the County of Wiltshire held in 1565 and 1623: the said Armorial Ensigns being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms: otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.

And to signify Her Royal Will and Pleasure that the said Royal Concession and Declaration be recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms.
