EAST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL (ROWLANDS HILL) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2010

Notice is hereby given that East Dorset District Council proposes to make a new parking order pursuant to powers contained in Sections 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The new parking order will be entitled the East Dorset District Council (Rowlands Hill) (Off Street Parking Places Order) 2010 ("the Order").

The Order will regulate the use of a new Car Park ("the Car Park") currently under construction at the new Waitrose retail store development at Rowlands Hill in Wimborne.

The terms of the Order will be the same as the East Dorset District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008 the parking order that controls the public car parks in Wimborne and Ferndown with the following exceptions:

The charges will be the same as the Council's 'short stay' car parking tariff (30p for up to 30 minutes, 60p for up to 1 hour and £1 for up to 2 hours) but there will be a maximum length of stay of 2 hours.

The Council's Short Stay, Long Stay, Resident's and Walford Mill parking permits will not be valid in the Car Park.

The Order will also contain an amendment to the East Dorset District Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008 to extend the area covered by that Order to include three parking bays accessed from Library Road and adjacent to the Penny's Lodge Car Park in Ferndown.

The Order would come into effect on the 8th July 2010.

A copy of the Order and maps showing the areas to which it relates, with a copy of the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the Council Offices, Furzehill, Wimborne.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds of your objection in writing to the Chief Executive, East
