THE EALING (FREE PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 200*

THE EALING (PARKING PLACES) (SPECIAL PERMIT) (NO. 1) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 200*

THE EALING (ACTON GREEN) (RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 20**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Free Parking Places Order would be to replace the 2 relocated car club bays in Acton Lane with free limited time parking bays. The bays and the adjacent existing 2 free parking bays would operate between 9am and 6pm on **Mondays to Saturdays** with a maximum stay of 30 minutes. No return would be permitted to the parking place for 1 hour. The free parking place in Church Path would be reduced by two bays to one bay to accommodate the car club bays.

3. The general effect of the Special Permit Order would be to relocate the parking places EACC 31 and EACC 32 for car club vehicles in Acton Lane W4 to Church Path where they would be sited in place of 2 bays of the free parking place in Church Path. The parking places
