THE A1 TRUNK ROAD AND THE A1(M) MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 45 TO JUNCTION 46) (TEMPORARY 50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2007

(REVOCAION)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway, in the District of Leeds, under sections 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order would be to revoke the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 45 to Junction 46) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2007 which came into force on 27 July 2007. This Order authorised a temporary 50mph speed restriction on the A1 and A1(M) from 100 metres north of the northern overbridge at the former Junction 45 (now Junction 44, Bramham Crossroads) to 3000 metres north of the northern overbridge at Junction 46 (Kirk Deighton), a distance of approximately 18,000 metres.

This restriction is no longer required now that the carriageway construction and widening works have been completed. The Revocation will come into force on Saturday 10 July 2010.

There will be no effect whatsoever on the existing on-street provision, restrictions or prohibitions in the roads designated under the said Orders being made.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
