

A length of footway and irregularly shaped area of highway that will form a new turning head, measuring 855 square metres, that extends from a point west of No. 118 Caer Castell Place and follows the eastern loop of Caer Castell Place to a point on the northern side of Caer Castell Place that lies to the east of Rumney High School (identified as Area 9 on the deposited plan).

An irregularly shaped area of highway forming a new turning head on the northern side of Caer Castell Place, measuring 227 square metres (identified as Area 10 on the deposited plan).

An irregularly shaped area of footway that extends in an easterly direction from a point to the east of No. 27 Caer Castell Place, measuring 169 square metres (identified as Area 11 on the deposited plan).

Description of the highway to be improved.

An irregularly shaped area of highway known as Caer Castell Place that extends in an easterly direction from a point east of No. 27 Caer Castell Place to a point northwest of the rear of Nos. 67 and 69 Letterston Road, measuring 1175 square metres (identified as Area 8 on the deposited plan).

Description of the proposed development.

The erection of a residential development of 50 dwellings comprising a mixture of house types and a block of flats with associated works and landscaping at Caer Castell Place, Rumney, Cardiff in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 by Cardiff Council on 5 March 2010 under reference number 09/01442/E.
