THE BROMLEY (FREE PARKING PLACE)(DISABLED PERSONS) ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT NO. 31) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2010.

(CRAB HILL, BROMLEY)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 16th December 2010 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 9 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) which will come into operation on 4th January 2011.

The effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) *introduce waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;*

(b) *introduce new disabled bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice.*

The scheme will be reviewed after being in operation for six months and if successful may be made permanent under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Orders, may, within a period of six months from the day on which the experimental Orders came into force, send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds on which it is made to the Director of Environment, Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent BR1 3UH, quoting reference ADE(TP)RP/T100/561.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:

CRAB HILL, Bromley, (a) both sides, (i) from the eastern boundary of No. 2 eastwards for a distance of 8.5m; (ii) from a point 51.5m east of the eastern boundary of No. 2 eastwards for a distance of 8.5m; (b) the north side, from the western kerbline of Ravensbourne Avenue westwards for a distance of 12m; (c) the south side, from the western kerbline of Ravensbourne Avenue westwards for a distance of 10m.

RAVENSBOURNE AVENUE, Bromley, (a) both sides, from a point 3m south of the southern flank wall of Nos. 275/277 southwards for a distance of 6m; (b) the west side, from a point 8.5m south of the southern kerbline of Crab Hill northwards to a point 5.5m north of the northern kerbline of Crab Hill; (c) the east side, from a point 17.5m south of a point opposite the southern kerbline of Crab Hill northwards for a distance of 31m.

RAVENSMEAD ROAD, Bromley, the north and east side, from the eastern boundary of No. 38 eastwards and southwards to the northern boundary of No. 36.

RIVERPARK GARDENS, Bromley, both sides, from the northern kerbline of Ravensmead Road northwards to a point 8m south of the southern flank wall of No. 1.

No Waiting between 11am and 3pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive:
