Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield (hereafter referred to as “the Council”) propose to make the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. \*) Order 201\* and the Enfield (20 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. \*) Traffic Order 201\* under sections 6, 84(1) and 84(2) and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to introduce —

(a) new “at any time” waiting restrictions in parts of **Bridle Close Enfield, Ordnance Road Enfield, Ramney Drive Enfield, Salisbury Road Enfield, Tysoe Avenue Enfield, Velocity Way Enfield, Warwick Road Enfield** and the **Unnamed access road leading to the rear of Nos. 331 to 379 Ordnance Road Enfield**;

(b) a 20 mph speed limit for motor vehicles in parts of **Ordnance Road** and **Velocity Way** at such times as are indicated by traffic signs (typically during school times); and

(c) a 20 mph speed limit for motor vehicles in the streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

3. FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to control the speed of traffic, the Council propose to construct under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980 a flat top speed table which would be constructed in Ordnance Road Enfield west of its junction with Medcalf Road Enfield.
