ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A1 TRUNK ROAD (DUNSTON INTERCHANGE) (WIDTH RESTRICTION) ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A1 Trunk Road in the District of Gateshead.

The effect of the Order, if made, will be to prohibit all vehicles with an overall width exceeding 6'6" from proceeding in the right hand or off side lane of the of the northbound carriageway of the A1 Trunk Road from 390 metres south of the centreline of Dunston Road Overbridge northwards for a distance of 640 metres.

Information provided in response to this consultation, including personal information, may be subject to publication or disclosure in accordance with the access to information regimes (these are primarily the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA) and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004).

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the 'Disabled Persons Parking Places' Order would be to:—

- designate parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
- provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
- specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge
