HE Court continues at the Elcurial, whither the Marquess de Lede went from hence on the 11th Instant, to receive the King's Orders for making the Reform refolved on among the Troops. On the 12th died fuddenly the Count de Castellar, whose Estate is fallen to the lafox. Count de Estevan who married his only Daughter. The King has promoted M. de Marfilly to the Rank of Lieutenant General An Express from Cadiz has brought Advice, that the Galleons failed from thence the 21st past for the West Indies, under the Command of Lieutenant-General Don Balthafar de Guevara. This Flota confisted of 15 Sail, viz. four Men of War, 9 Merchant-Ships, and two Advice Ships

Copenhagen, July 19, N. S. On the 15th In-ftant the King declared Count ReventklauGreat The Queen of Denmark made Chamberlain. her publick Entry the next Day into this City from Fredericksberg, all the Burghers being under Arms. The Procession was begun by all the Counfellours of Justice and those of State on Horseback; these were followed by 36 Coaches of the Nobility, each drawn by fix Horses. The Queen's Coach was drawn by eight Horles, and in it fat the young Princels with her Majefty. The King, who had come to Town Incognito, received the Queen at the Palace. There was a very Magnifi-cent Entertainment at Court, above 60 Per-fons dined with the King, and the reft at the Marshal's Table. The King supped that Evening with the Queen at her Houle near the Palace, and went back to Fredericksberg the fame Night. The Court went this Morning to Fredericksburg, where they intend to flay fome Days; and afterwards 'tis faid the King will go to Holflein.

Berlin, July 19. On the 14th Inftant the King of Pruffia returned hither from his Progrefs into Pruffia. On the 16th the Lord Whitworth, the British Minister, had Audience of his Msjefty; and on the 17th fee out for the Hague. M. Weftphale, the late Danish Envoy at Petersbourg, having received Orders from his Court to go to Drefden, to no-

in his Way back to Copenh gen. Paris, July 26. M. d'Ormelon, one of the . Commiffioners of the Finances is made Counfellour of State, in the Room of M. de Trudaine lately decealed. The Duke d' Aumont was taken ill on the 23d Inftant of a Fit of Apoplexy, and continues in very great Danger. The Jeluits have been endeavouring underhand to obtain Leave to establish an University at Dijon ; but that of Paris having got Notice of their Defign, oppoles it very firenuoully. A Courier arrived here Yefterday in the Afternoon from Rome, with the News of the Pope's having named the Archbishop of Cambray and Don Alex. Albani to the Dignity of Cardi-nale. The Court has received a Letter from the Marquels de Pons, who commands at Toulon, with Advice, that the hot Weather had much diminished the Plague in that City. They write from Languedoc, that the Lines which had been drawn lately round la Canourgue were extended, in order to take in two small Villages in the Neighbourhood of that Place, which were suspected of the Infection.
